



## **Mossbourne Clivebourne Sixth Form Proposed Admission Arrangements for 2019/20**

The Academy has capacity in its Sixth Form for 400 students across two year groups and so the admission number for entry to Year 12 is 200, minus those Year 11 students eligible to transfer from Mossbourne Community Academy and Mossbourne Victoria Park Academy. To facilitate a wider range of courses for minority subjects, the Academy may liaise with other Post 16 institutions in Hackney.

All students must meet the minimum entry requirements.

After the admission of students with Education, Health and Care Plans (EHCPs), where Mossbourne Clivebourne Sixth Form is named on the EHCP, and where the Academy can best meet the needs of the student, the following criteria will be applied:

1. A looked after child or a child who was previously looked after but immediately after being looked after became subject to an adoption order, child arrangement or special guardianship order. A looked after child is a child who is (a) in the care of a local authority, or (b) being provided with accommodation by a local authority in the exercise of their social services functions.
2. Students who have studied at Mossbourne Community Academy or Mossbourne Victoria Park Academy in Year 11
3. External students

The deadline for applications is the 11<sup>th</sup> of January of the year of admission. Late applicants will only be considered if space remains in the Mossbourne Clivebourne Sixth Form. Students making late applications should be aware that spaces may only be available on a limited number of courses.

Students, both internal and external, will be offered a consultation meeting before deciding their options.

The governors will allocate places on oversubscribed courses, in priority order, to those students (both internal and external) with the highest points score in their seven best GCSEs, which must include English and Maths. Students meeting the minimum academic entry requirements to whom we are unable to offer places on their chosen courses, will be offered alternatives where possible.

Entry into Year 13 is not automatic. Entry is assessed on the basis of the successful completion of Year 12.

### **Academic entry requirements:**

Applicants will have gained 7 GCSEs at Grade 4 (or equivalent), including English & Maths. In addition, the minimum course requirements for each subject must be met, as specified in the Clivebourne Sixth Form Subject Guide which can be found on the website: [www.mca.mossbourne.org](http://www.mca.mossbourne.org).

**Conditional Offers**

Applicants will be notified of conditional offers by 3 March 2019. Applicants not given a conditional offer will also be notified on this date.

**Appeals:**

In the event of a place not being offered at Mossbourne Clivebourne Sixth Form, the applicant has the right of appeal to an independent appeals panel. Appeals will be heard during September 2019.
